- The ED nurse/tech will obtain EKG within 9 minutes of patient arrival to room who is complaining of chest pain.
- The ED nurse will initiate safety net, which includes vital signs, monitor, IV access and oxygen as needed.
- The ED nurse will recognize ST elevation on monitor, notify MD to patient with possible acute MI.
- The ED nurse will obtain CT chest to r/o dissection as ordered by ED MD.
- The ED nurse will verbalize goal-oriented report to nurse who will be receiving sign-out on this patient.
